


• Share the information with the concerned stakeholders and encourage them to avail these opportunities.

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

The sports events are organized at Cluster/ Zonal and National level. The participants receive Participation Certificates and the winners receive Medals and Merit Certificates. Sports Grant is given to the organizing schools by the Board.

The CBSE Games Policy contains comprehensive guidelines for organizing and participation in CBSE Games. It touches all essential aspects including responsibilities of organizing schools, safety measures, participant eligibility criteria, disqualification rules etc. The policy will serve a holistic approach to promote sports among students fostering their personal development and overall wellbeing.
